Hollis Roberson Scholarship for Enhanced Professional Development

Hollis Roberson, CLU, FMLI, RHU was truly a Texas legend whose accomplishments would fill many volumes, having worked tirelessly in the insurance industry for 34 years. His work with the National and Texas Associations of Health Underwriters is memorialized in the awarding each year the top honor of TAHU – The Hollis Roberson Award. Because of Hollis' support of all forms of professional insurance development, the Hollis Roberson Scholarship for Enhanced Professional Development was established to help Texas Association of Health Underwriters members who have earned NAHU's Designations or Certifications. The scholarship goal is for the recipient to continue in the health insurance industry, ensuring the future of the industry.
